#### DISCUSS PARK CAPITAL EXPENDITURES AND LONG TERM BUDGET

The Capital Expenditures worksheet has been updated to reflect the Board's discussion in October. Lloyd Diehl, Little League Coordinator, has been contacted for information regarding the ball fields.

The Board agreed to make tennis court resurfacing a 2018 priority.

The base and floor of the gazebo will need replacing in 2018, the Board agreed to discuss with Boy Scout Luke DaSilva as a potential Eagle Scout project.

Cardno submitted their proposal for the eradication of buckthorn in Beverly Park. They suggest two different cut zones, and recommend a two-year maintenance program after the initial cut in both zones. That includes three foliar treatments throughout an entire cut zone in the first year, followed by two foliar treatments throughout the entire zone in year two.

The initial cutting would occur during the dormant season (November – March) with maintenance during the growing season (April – October). They would secure a Department of Environmental Quality ANC (Aquatic Nuisance Control) permit which is required due to the presence of wetlands in the work zones. Their proposal for this program is \$64,875. Village administration is currently researching available grants to help offset the cost of such a program. This proposal will be submitted to Council at the joint meeting in January.
