Dear Village/City Resident:

The 13 Mile Road Reconstruction Project (Evergreen to Southfield) is prepped and ready for final paving. Unfortunately, the weather is not cooperating and is not forecasted to dry up for a couple days. The final wearing course of asphalt cannot be placed until the asphalt course beneath it is sufficiently dry (or else poor adhesion of the layers will occur and result in potentially reduced performance). The contractor has a crew on standby waiting for acceptable conditions and will pave the final wearing course as soon as possible once the weather cooperates.

After the final course of asphalt is placed (which should take two to three days), aggregate shoulders will need to be placed and then joints in the pavement will be sealed. Once these operations have occurred, the roadway will be ready to accept permanent pavement markings (i.e. striping of the lane lines, stop bars, turn arrows, etc.). Depending on how quickly the pavement marking contractor can make it to site, the roadway will remain under its current traffic control or the roadway will be opened up to two-way traffic under temporary pavement markings. Our goal is to open the road to two-way traffic as quickly and as safely as possible.

Thank you for your patience during the 13 Mile Road reconstruction project, we know it has not been convenient, but the project is in the home stretch and, weather permitting, we still plan to meet our anticipated completion date at the end of October.
